Themes and Education

The show is designed to suit a mixed-aged audience across Key Stages 1 and 2. It supports many of the teaching objectives in the *Science Programmes of Study: Key Stages 1 and 2's National Curriculum* including

- Identifying animal categories
- Identifying habitats and issues of habitat change
- Understanding adaptation and animal biology
- Understanding food chains and diet specifications
- Animal conservation methods and programmes

The show also introduces awareness to organisations which protect natural ecosystems such as FSC and the Rainforest Alliance.
